This is a grammar of the Blin Language written by Leo Reinisch in 1882. It is written in Blin and German texts, as a part of another book called "*Sitzungsberichte der Philosophischen Classe der Kaiserlichen, Akademie der Wissenschaften* (page 583-718).

This book is appreciated as the most complete grammar of Blin still today by contemporary linguists like Prof. David Appleyard. As the book is written mostly in German texts, it is understandable that foreigners who study Blin find Leo Reinisch's Blin Grammar of 1883 more helpful than recent Blin Grammar manuals written entirely in Blin, by Blin speakers.

A replication of this book, which is restored in a form as close to the original one as possible is printed on demand and sold by some of the well-known international bookshops.
